



Use of Race Track When Track Closed following Official Practice or Racing Event

Recognizing the usefulness of introducing new entrants to the sport of karting and the desire of some to provide equipment for the use of prospective new members, the following procedures shall govern the use of the race track following official events:

1. The driver must have attained 8 years of age and shall purchase a temporary one-day MKA membership (\$5.00)
2. A member of the MKA Executive shall be present and shall control access to the track. The designated official shall brief the driver pertaining to general track safety rules and shall complete a cursory technical inspection of the kart.
3. Appropriate insurance waivers, including Parental Consent and Minors Assumption of liability forms must be signed.
4. Only one kart at a time shall be permitted on the race track.
5. The driver must be monitored by at least one flag marshal who may be designated by the MKA Executive member present.
6. A barrier shall remain in place at the grid entrance until the driver exits the track.
7. Failure to comply with these safety measures shall result in the loss of racing privileges for the sponsoring MKA member(s).
