Subject: Clarification of the ASN Licence Categories and Classes in the Section 2 table

Effective Date: July 6, 2018

2. ASN NATIONAL LICENCE CATEGORIES AND CLASSES

2.1. National Licence and Age Requirements

- a) Bona-fide proof of age must be available at all times and is required to be shown to a Race Official if requested.
- b) **Minimum Age Requirements:** The minimum age for any class must be achieved in the year of application, for example if a driver is 7 years old and applies for a grade C or D licence, they must have their 8th birthday in the year of application.
- c) **Maximum Age Requirements:** A Briggs and Stratton driver who achieves the maximum age for their grade during the year, can complete that year at that grade.

Rotax and Rok Junior drivers must have their 16th birthday after December 31 of the current year to be eligible for the Grand Finals.

- d) **Classes:** A driver can run in any class that has the same grade of licence that they have been issued, for example a driver with a B licence can run in any class that requires a B licence. Once a driver moves up a class, for example from D to C or C to B or B to A they will not be eligible to go back to a lower class. The exception to this rule is that Briggs & Stratton Cadet and Rok Mini drivers can compete with a C or D licence in these two classes only, with no penalty.

2.2. Briggs & Stratton

Licence Grade	Class
D	Cadet - 8 to 11
C	Junior Lite - 11 to 14
B	Junior - 12 to 15
A	Senior and Masters <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Senior, 15th birthday during the current calendar year • Masters, 30th Birthday during the current calendar year or 200 lbs or more

2.3. Rok Age Limits (to qualify for the Rok Cup Trophy) as stated in the Rok Cup Trophy Regulations

Licence Grade	Class
C	Mini - -9-13 Years Old (Up To 14 Years Old Not Turned)
B	Junior - 11-15 Years Old (Up To 16 Years Old Not Turned)
A	Senior - From 14 Years Old (From 13 Years Old If 14 By the End of The Current Year)
A	Masters - From 14 years old (from 13 years old if 14 by the end of the current year) if the weight of the driver with helmet and racing suit is 85Kg or more. From 32 years old (from 31 years old if 32 by the end of the current year)
A	Shifter - From 15 years old (from 14 years old if 15 by the end of the current year)

2.4. Rotax Max Age Limits (to qualify for the RMCGF) as stated in the Rotax Max Regulations.

Licence Grade	Class
D	Micro – 8-11* Years Old (2007-2010*)
C	Mini - -10-13* Years Old (2005-2008*)
B	Junior - 12-15* Years Old (2003-2006)
A	Max - From 14-99 Years Old (till 2004)
A	Max Masters - From 32-99 years old (till 1986)
A	DD2 – 15-99 Years Old (till 2003)
A	DD2 Masters – 32-99 Years Old (till 1986)

*The age limits for MICRO, MINI and JUNIOR classes may be changed according to regulations of the national ASN of the Grand Finals hosting country.

MICRO, MINI and JUNIOR classes are run as a national event with international participation at the RMCGF 2018. See Supplementary Regulation for detailed information.

Example: To participate in the JUNIOR class, the driver must have his/her 12th birthday during the year of the event and must have his/her 16th birthday after the year of the event.
